All parents have signed a declaration of support for the Uniform Policy in their admission form - you are asked to continue this support.

If for any reason a child cannot comply with the Uniform Policy, a written note must be sent to school. It is the parents' responsibility to rectify the problem as soon as possible.

YEAR SEVEN RUGBY KNIT JUMPER - Year 7 students may wear throughout the year.

School uniform must be worn in a correct and appropriate manner both in and outside of the school grounds.

General Requirements

Hats - Navy blue slouch hat with logo. Legionnaires hat with logo has been superseded. **The school has a strict NO HAT - NO PLAY policy for all students. During Term 1 and 4, and when the UV rating is over 3 during Term 2 and 3, hats must be worn. Students are expected to have a hat at school all year.**

Art Smocks - Plain navy blue Reception - Year 7.

School Bags - Navy blue with school logo. Available in three sizes from The Uniform Shop.

Chair Bags - Used by our junior primary students to keep their belongings in. They are available from The Uniform Shop or alternatively a pattern is available should you like to make one (Please see Office)

Rain/Wind Jacket - Must be navy or black. These items can be purchased from The Uniform Shop and are optional.

Scarves and Gloves - must be navy. (Optional).

Hair - Shoulder length or longer hair should be tied back. No hair should fall on the face or over the eyes of a student. Hair cuts should be no less than a number 2 and hair should be of natural colour, neat, clean and tidy.

Hair Accessories - Hair clips, headbands, ribbons or hairbands to be navy or plain colour to blend with the hair or fabric to match uniform. No claws, combs, butterfly clips etc.

Jewellery - Students may wear a watch, a necklace with a small cross around their necks, or silver /gold single sleepers/studs in pierced ears in the lower lobe. No rings, anklets, bangles, bracelets or other adornments are permitted.

Makeup - No makeup is to be worn to school. This includes nail polish.

School Shoes - Black leather school lace-up shoe with black shoe laces OR Black leather elastic sided boots to be worn by both girls and boys all year round. Girls may wear black leather school shoes with buckle or velcro strap. Girls are not permitted to wear black leather shoes with higher than normal heels. Black canvas/fabric fashion shoes do not offer enough support and are not permitted.

School Sandals - Should be leather T-Bar or Roman style. Fashion or surf sandals are not permitted.

Sport Shoes Sandshoes - Lace-up or velcro sport shoes predominantly white with white shoelaces are acceptable. Canvas sandshoes do not offer enough support and are not permitted.

Exemption

If there is a medical reason for a child not being able to comply with the requirements in the uniform policy please notify the Principial for an exemption.

Extreme Weather Conditions

Children are permitted to wear full Winter or Summer uniform at the parents discretion.

Daily Physical Education

Children are encouraged to bring sports shoes for daily Physical Education sessions, but **MUST** change back into school shoes afterwards.

All Year Round Uniform Choices

- Navy blue short or long sleeved polo shirt with ELC and HCCS logos
- Plain navy blue fleecy track pant, shorts or skorts
- Navy blue polar fleece jumper with half zip and logos
- Navy blue broad brimmed hat with HCCS logo
- Closed in Shoes, Sneakers or Sandals - no thongs

PLEASE NOTE: This is the preferred Uniform chosen by parents but not compulsory. Alternatively please dress your children in similar coloured clothing.

Secondhand Uniform Policy

- Garments must be **correct uniform** as stated in this policy. Superseded uniforms will not be sold as secondhand uniforms. Any garment which is not correct uniform will be donated to charity.
- No shoes, socks or tights will be accepted for sale.
- Garments should be in good condition, clean, ironed and stain free.
- HCCS will receive 50% of the sale price as commission, or items can be donated.
- Commission garments will receive 50% of the sale price and credited to the family's school account at the earliest convenience. If the family has left the school, funds will be deposited into the nominated bank account.
- Cash sales - please try to have correct money if possible. Eftpos is available. No amounts to be charged to School accounts.
- No garments will be returned.
- Any un-named, unclaimed school uniform items in lost property will go to the second hand uniform pool after one term.
- It is at the discretion of the second hand uniform convener to sell any garment that has faded.
